



Role-playing allows children to experience scenes that they would not face regularly.

Children act out what they have observed. They try to recreate their experience during the role play.





Children learn from their surroundings. Role-playing helps children develop social and emotional intelligence.

Children learn complex skills like negotiation, bargaining, judgment, valuing the opinions and ideas of others, making plans, and putting them to practice.





Children learn better when in social situations. They need opportunities to socialize with their peers or willing adults to combine learning skills and acquire new knowledge.

When children cannot go out, role-playing helps to meet their physical exercise requirements.





Role-playing also helps develop gross and fine motor skills.
