Horse Toys



Safety

Opt for lead- and BPA-free toys that meet CPSC standards.



Choking hazard

Ensure the toy doesn't have small detachable parts that can be choking hazards.

Durability

Look for toys that resist wear and tear, as children generally engage in rough play.



Additional features

Toys with added features, such as sounds, can improve your child's imagination and add to their experience.

Battery operation

If the toy operates on a battery, ensure the battery case secures properly. Remove batteries from the toy when not in use.
