

REASONS FOR OVARIAN PAIN DURING PREGNANCY



ACCOMMODATION CHANGES



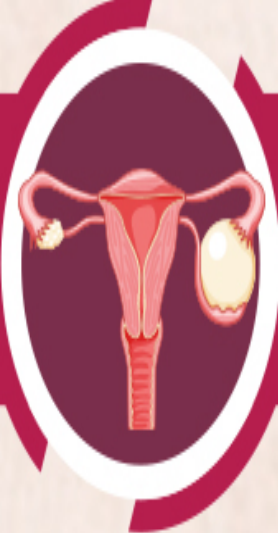
The stretching of the pelvic region to accommodate the expanding uterus may cause pain in the ovaries.

ECTOPIC PREGNANCY

This is when the egg implants outside the uterus in the fallopian tube, leading to complications such as pain and bleeding.



OVARIAN RUPTURE OR TORSION



The functional cyst in the ovaries may sometimes grow bigger and rupture, or its weight can cause the ovaries to twist, leading to pain.

ROUND LIGAMENT PAIN

The round ligament supporting the growing uterus stretches around the second trimester, leading to mild or acute pain in the lower belly.



MISCARRIAGE



A miscarriage may happen in any pregnancy due to different abnormalities and cause pelvic or ovarian pain.
