Each four-square-mile patch of rainforest has about 750 tree species, 150 butterfly species, 1500 flowering plants, and 400 bird species.



Around 80% of the flowers in the Australian rainforests cannot be found anywhere else in the world.



Rainforests in Brazil and central Africa are still the home to many tribes, having no contact with the outside world.



The Amazon Rainforest could make it the ninth-largest country in the world.
