WHEN TO VISIT A DOCTOR



You should contact your healthcare provider if the baby exhibits the following signs, in addition to not blowing raspberries, after six months of age.



Does not make an eye contact

Rare or the absence of smiling, babbling, and talking



Cannot sit unsupported

Exhibits unilateral body weakness



Has trouble swallowing soft food or pushing food out of their mouth

Does not laugh or squeal



Does not bring things to the mouth

Does not reach out for things within reach
