## LAST NAMES



### Bayard

A legendary horse significant to the romance of the medieval period. The name is derived from the Old French word "baiart," meaning 'bay-colored.'



### Churchill

The famous surname means 'someone who lives by the church on the hill.' The name synonymous with Churchill is Sir Winston Churchill, Britain's Prime Minister during WWII.



### Douglas

A Scottish surname meaning 'dark water,' Douglas used to be a powerful Scottish lowland clan.



### Hamilton

This last name was derived from the Old English word meaning 'a crooked hill'. Alexander Hamilton was one of the famous name bearers who founded the United States.



### Talbot

A name of Norman origin, Talbot, is believed to be derived from a Germanic given name meaning 'to destroy a message.'
