Celiac Disease



The immune system reacts to the gluten in the food, leading to decreased appetite, bloating, and weight loss.



Crohn's Disease

A rare inflammatory bowel disease that causes inflammation in the gastrointestinal tract.

Ulcerative Colitis



An inflammatory bowel disease, similar to Crohn's disease, but affecting only the large intestine.



Graves' Disease

Antibodies attach to thyroid glands and stimulate excess thyroid hormone production, leading to various symptoms.
