

Guiding Children Through Their Superhero Play Phase



Help them understand that the on-screen actions cannot be replicated in real life and how it can be dangerous for them.



Be mindful of the language they are using. For this, you must pay attention to the type of superhero movies they watch.



Teach them that the superheroes may be fictional, but their powers are symbols of real-life characteristics such as strength and willpower.



You may use examples of heroes such as Spiderman to teach them about responsibility as the famous line goes, "With great power comes great responsibility."



Let them enjoy this phase to keep their imagination and creativity flowing by participating in their role plays so you may guide them in the right direction.
