



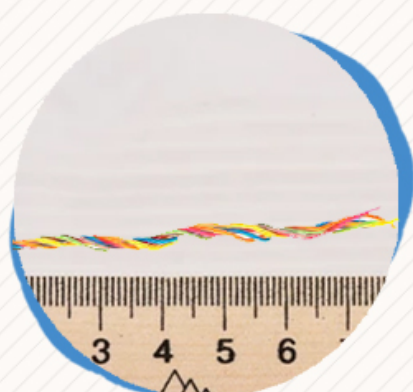
How To Measure A Child's Head Before Buying A Bike Helmet?

Ensure the child stands straight and looks straight ahead while measuring. Remove hair clips and undo ponytails for an accurate measurement.



Measure the child's head circumference using tailor's tape.

Alternatively, use a string to measure the circumference and measure it against a ruler.



Note the circumference at the thickest part of the head, approximately one inch above the eyebrows.

Compare the measurement with the size range provided by the helmet manufacturer.

55cm	S 21 5/8" - 22"
56cm	S 55cm - 56cm
57cm	M 22 3/8" - 22 3/4"
58cm	M 57cm - 58cm
59cm	L 23 1/8" - 23 1/2"
60cm	L 59cm - 60cm
61cm	XL 23 7/8" - 61cm



Select a snug-fitting helmet that will sit at a two-finger width from the eyebrows.
