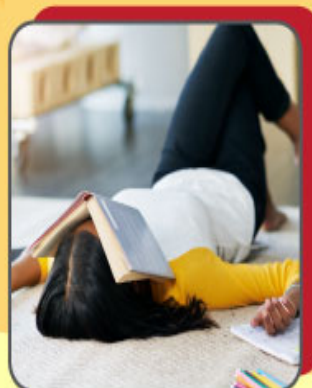




Key Moral Dilemmas For Teens
