



## Tips For Safely Using Nebulizers In Babies



Stay with your baby throughout the duration of the nebulizer treatment.

If your baby vomits or coughs badly, pause the treatment. Resume once they have settled.



If the medicine is a corticosteroid, wipe the inside of your baby's mouth and tongue with a wet cloth after the treatment to prevent ingestion of any residual medicine.

The nebulizer should fit right and be cleaned properly to prevent the risk of infections, eye irritation, mouth irritation, and delivery of too much or insufficient medicine.



Place the nebulizer on a clean, flat table surface while using it. Placing it on a rug or carpet may draw fibers into the machine.

The nebulizer machine should not come in contact with water or other liquid while connected to electric mains.
