

# Things To Consider

## Before Buying A Baby Monitor

Consider the battery life of the baby monitor in both audio and video modes before purchasing.



Check for good video and sound quality, with the ability to pick up on slight noises or distress calls.



Look for a baby monitor with night vision to see the child and room in the dark.



A light activation feature that activates on sound can help signal when the child is awake, especially at night when the volume may be muted or low.



Consider the range of your monitor and whether it can reach all the areas of your home or yard.



Check if there is a two-way communication system to help you calm the baby through the baby monitor when they are upset.
