

## POINTS TO REMEMBER WHEN TAKING FEXOFENADINE **DURING LACTATION**

Ask your doctor for the lowest dose.





Breastfeed before taking the medicine to reduce the baby's exposure.

Consult your doctor if the baby shows unusual symptoms, such as fussiness and altered feeding patterns.





Avoid drinking fruit juices of apple, grapefruit, or orange as they may affect drug absorption.

Allow a two-hour gap between antacids containing aluminum/magnesium and fexofenadine.





Avoid taking this drug before tests, such as allergy skin testing, to prevent interference with results.
