PHYSIOLOGICAL ALTERATIONS

KOILONYCHIA

- Nail surface is flat or concave (spooning)
- Resolves as nail plate thickens with age







ONYCHOSCHIZIA

- Splitting of the nails
- Usually caused by an injury
- Requires no specific treatment

PIGMENTATION OF THE **NAIL FOLD**

- The nail folds appear light brt or ochre
- Condition is harmless





BEAU'S LINES

- Side-to-side depression along a single line
- Caused by intrauterine distress or during birth
- Resolves in 14 weeks

PATHOLOGICAL ALTERATIONS

CLUBBING



- around them May occur due to congenital heart, lung,
- or intestinal disorders

NAIL-PATELLA SYNDROME



- Causes abnormalities in nails, knees, and elbows
- Underdeveloped triangular nails

NAIL-PATELLA SYNDROME



 Chalky buildup under the nails Small, thin, and brittle nails
