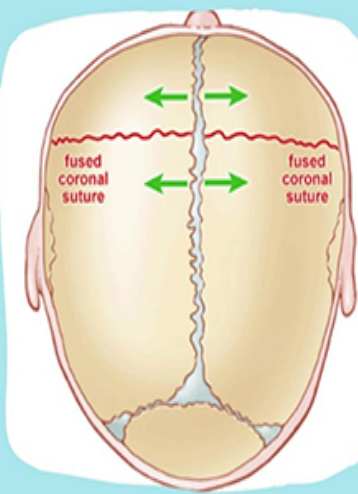

Unilateral lambdoid synostosis

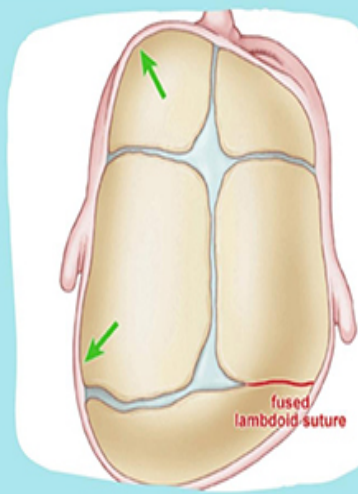
