

Place the playpen away from curtains, windows, and electrical appliances to avoid accidents.





Double-check the playpen locks to ensure they are properly secured.

Fasten the zippers completely to prevent the child from getting trapped.





Remove the bassinet and changing pad before placing the baby in the pen.

Do not add blankets or pillows to reduce the risk of suffocation.





Avoid attaching mobiles to the pen to prevent the baby from climbing out.

Refrain from adding big stuffed toys to the playpen.





Adhere to the weight and height limits of the playpen.
