ORIGIN

- First played in the early 1930s
- Elsa Maxwell is credited for its discovery



HOPSCOTCH

ORIGIN

- Originated in the early Roman empire
- First documented to be played in ancient Britain
- The game was also believed to have been used for military training



JUMP ROPE

ORIGIN

- First believed to be played in the 16th century
- Popular for its use by Egyptians for jumping with vines
- The game has many variations, and each has a different origin

TUG OF WAR

ORIGIN

- No definite origin reported
- Believed to be played as a part of ancient rituals in various parts of the world
- The game was part of the summer Olympics held between 1900 and 1920
