

FOR CHILDREN TO LEARN DOSITIVITY



Build an "AFFIRMATION

BOARD" and have your children fill it with things they wish to accomplish, positive things about themselves, or the person they want to become.



Encourage them to learn and sing

"AFFIRMATION SONGS"

that promote positivity and confidence,
or try making a song of your own out of
motivational words.



Have your children write down or stick self-encouraging

"WORDS ON THE MIRROR"
so that they will see a confident
young individual every time
they look at the mirror.



Form an "AFFIRMATION CIRCLE" and let each child take turns to say one positive affirmation out loud to motivate themselves and others.



OF THE DAY" and let the children read one positive affirmation every morning before they begin their day.



affirmation such as 'I am helpful' on one side of a small cut-out cardboard coin and the helpful deed they did on the other side.
