


Do not mix paracetamol with other medication, such as ibuprofen, unless directed by a doctor.



Always check the expiration date before using it, and only use it if the date is visible.



Do not prepare the medicine in advance; only take it out of the bottle or the foil when the child is ready to consume it.



Take note of the doses of paracetamol given and maintain a gap of six hours between each dose.



Do not give more than four doses of paracetamol per day.



If the fever or pain worsens or persists after 48 hours of taking paracetamol, see a doctor immediately.
