Tickling game



- Place your baby in a comfortable position.

To-and-fro imitation game

- The next time they imitate you, you imitate them back. Make the same sounds to make them coo and chuckle.

- Pick a toy and make the relevant sounds.
- Cover your face with animal toys while playing peek-a-boo and make fun noises.
- Play musical toys around them to introduce them to new sounds.

Tongue teazer



- Pull out your tongue and start to blow raspberries.
- Make cooing noises once your baby starts to giggle.

Dance along



- Play the sound that excites your baby.
- Hold them and perform a few gentle steps on the beats.
- Feel free to sing the songs to encourage them to coo.
