

Goalkeepers may use any body part to stop a shot at the goal while inside the circle.




When stopping the ball with hands, it must hit the hand, fall straight down, and not be propelled forward.



They may put on or remove any protective clothing or equipment before a penalty stroke.



If goalkeepers deliberately infringe inside the circle, it will result in a penalty stroke.



During a short corner, goalkeepers may lie down only after the ball has been hit.



An on-field player may become a 'kicking back' if a goalkeeper needs to leave the field.



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
