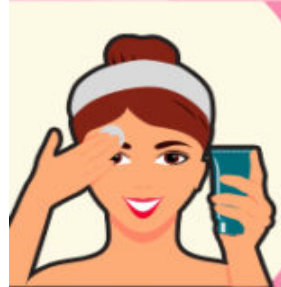




How To Ensure Eye Safety When Applying Makeup

Avoid using makeup if the skin around the eye is inflamed until it heals.



Apply and remove the eye makeup as gently as possible.

Keep the makeup products sheltered from dirt and dust.



Avoid using makeup products, especially mascaras, once they have expired.

Avoid using makeup products stored at temperatures above 85°F.



Never moisten dried-up mascaras with saliva or water, as it may cause germ buildup.

Never apply or remove eye makeup when commuting.



Avoid sharing your eye makeup products with others to reduce the risk of infections.
