

SAFETY TIPS TO USE A **SEAT BELT FOR A CHILD**

- Know the vehicle you are traveling in, as your child may still need a booster seat in some vehicles.
- Make sure the car seat belt fits your child correctly.
- Do not fasten the shoulder strap of the seat belt under a child's arm or behind their back.
- Do not share a seat belt with your child or between two children.





ISOFIX SEATS VS. SEAT BELTS

- Isofix seat systems are secure and let you attach a child seat, preventing it from rotating in case of a crash.
- The system is better than securing a child seat with a seat belt only.
- Not all cars have Isofix, while seat belts are ubiquitous.
