as children love to imitate. Your children will be encouraged to do the same if you follow good practices.



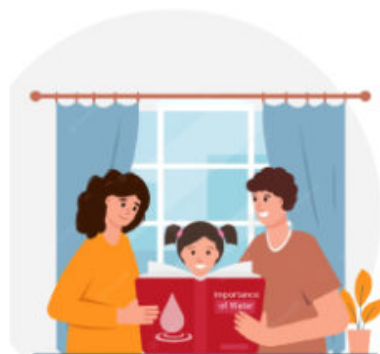
LETTING THEM HAVE FREQUENT CONTACT
