

Interesting Games To Teach Spellings To Children



Match the spelling



Give your child a picture card and two spelling cards (one with the wrong spelling and the other with a correct one). Ask them to match the picture with the correct spelling and then spell the word aloud.

Add a letter



Ask your child to give a letter. Then, add another letter to it in an attempt to form a word. Take turns adding letters to complete the word. When a word is formed, start with another letter to form a new word.

Writing in the cloud



Ask your child to spell a word that they have recently learned. While spelling the word, ask them to say each letter aloud and write it in the air. For more fun, let them exaggerate their actions as they write.

Writing on the back



Give your child a word and ask them to spell it by writing each letter on your back. As they write the letters, you guess them and say them aloud. For every correct spelling they write, give them a point.

Rainbow writing



This is a fun spelling practice game where children write the spelling of the word seven times using one rainbow color each time. Using different colors will keep children excited about the practice.
