Facts About ADOLESCENT CHILDBEARING

- In 2020, the teen pregnancy rate was 15.4, which was a drop of 75 percent from 1990.
- Although the teenage pregnancy rate has decreased yearly since 2009, the US still has the highest teen pregnancies among other developed countries.
- In 2020, 76 percent of all teenage births occurred among 18 to 19-year-olds.
- exposure to substance abuse and violence, parental separation, and poor education are some leading causes of teen pregnancy.
- Three out of every ten US girls get pregnant at least before they turn 20.
- Eight out of ten teenage fathers do not marry the mother of their child.
- Teen pregnancy is the primary reason for teen girls dropping out of school.
 - 1/4th of teen mothers are already pregnant with their second child within 24 months of their first child.
