

A Simple Guide To

FLYING A KITE



launcher



The one who holds the kite is the "launcher," and the one flying it is the "flier."

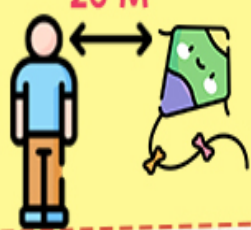

The launcher should be opposite the wind direction, with the kite facing them.

Do not launch the kite while running, as it may crash.



Stand at a 20 meters distance from the kite, ensuring no obstructions.

Release the kite when there is a strong gust of wind while the flier provides friction by pulling the string.



Both the launcher and the flier need to adjust to the direction of the wind to keep the line straight.

To bring the kite down, the flier should pull the line and wrap it around the coil.
