

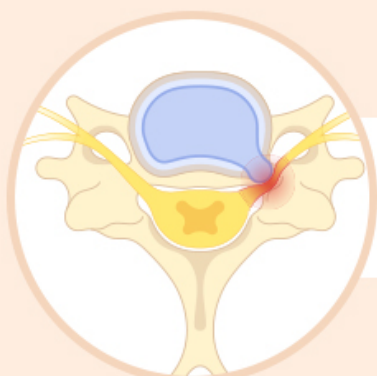
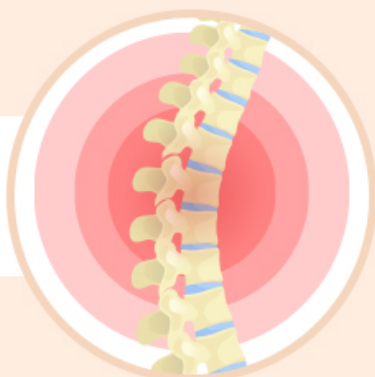
WHAT CAN THE GRASPING REFLEX — IN BABIES — INDICATE?

Reasons for the absence of the grasping reflex in babies aged 6 months and less



Brain injury

Spinal cord injury



Nerve damage

Accidental head injury or severe concussions

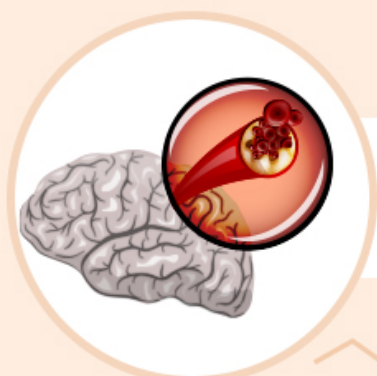


Reasons for the persistence of the grasping reflex in babies aged more than 6 months



Spastic cerebral palsy

Neuromuscular disorders



Cortical lesions

Diminished cortical activity due to injury or severe illness
