Encourage them to embrace their roots by participating in cultural activities, learning the languages, and celebrating the festivals.



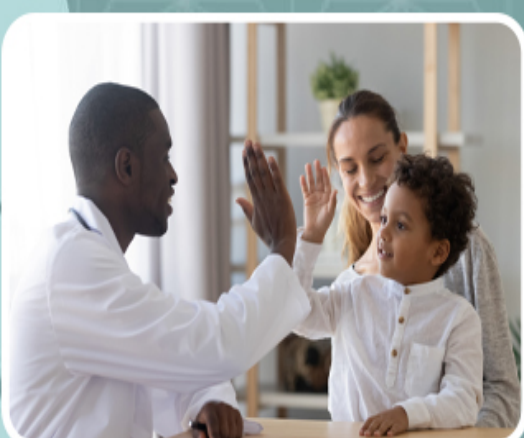
Talk openly about race and diversity to help them understand the world around them.
