

SIMPLE TIPS TO GET YOUR CONTOUR

RIGHT



Brushes:

Choose good-quality brushes to blend the makeup products properly. While kabuki brushes work well for blending the contour, small brushes are good for highlighting the nose.

Shades:

Ensure the product shades match your skin's tone for a smooth, even finish. Choose a contour three times darker than your actual skin tone.



Application:

Observe your face and identify the places that need depth. Contour the jawbone or below your cheekbones. Apply bronzer or highlighter where the light hits well to get a warm, sunkissed finish.

Skin type:

If you have oily skin, powder formulas can give you a smooth, matte look. Cream-based products work best with dry skin since they moisturize.



Setting:

Blend carefully to ensure there are no harsh lines. Also, use setting powder or a setting spray to help your makeup stay for long.
