



TIPS TO KEEP YOUR BABY SAFE WHEN TRAVELING TO MALARIA-ENDEMIC REGIONS

Find out detailed information on parts of the world where malaria transmission occurs.



Check for the specific drug that the CDC recommends to be effective for a particular region.

If your stay is going to be longer, check if your baby is eligible for an experimental malaria vaccine.



Educate yourself about the symptoms of malaria.

Dress the baby in appropriate clothing to prevent mosquito bites.



Use infant-friendly mosquito repellents.

Use bed nets treated with pyrethroid insecticide to get maximum protection.



Keep yourself informed about the local malaria clinics at the place of visit
