



Car Seat Types Suitable For *Four-Year-Olds*

Convertible car seats



- Adapt to the growing child
- Include all-in-one seats, from rear-facing to forward-facing, and booster seat

Combination car seats



- Are forward-facing seats
- Come with a harness (for children weighing 40 to 65 pounds) and without a harness (for children weighing up to 100–120 pounds)

Integrated seats



- Are built-in forward-facing seats in the car
- Not suitable for children unless they reach the highest weight or height allowed for rear-facing convertible car safety seat

Travel vests



- Are suitable for children weighing 22 to 168 pounds
- Require the use of a top tether to hold the child securely in a rear seat

Booster seats



- Suitable for children weighing more than 40 pounds to lift them to the right height for the lap and shoulder belts
- Come in two types — high back and backless booster seats
