



What Are The Different Kinds Of Electric Race Car Toy Tracks?

Plastic tracks



- Inexpensive molded plastic tracks made in sections
- Readily available but does not provide a smooth run

Routed tracks

- Made with sheet board and other polymer materials
- Smoother surface but less durability



Analog or slot car tracks



- Features a dedicated lane for each miniature car
- Gives a realistic racing experience but requires more maintenance

Digital tracks

- Features complex tracks to allow cars to switch lanes
- Can control multiple cars on the same track



Magnetic Tracks



- Uses magnets in the cars to keep the cars on track with more stability
- Suitable for beginners
