1 Certain infections



2 Anal or rectal bleeding



3 Ingestion of a foreign body



Abnormal blood vessels



Fresence of leafy greens, beetroot, or tomatoes in the maternal diet

Consult a pediatrician soon since you may not be able to determine the underlying cause, and some of the reasons require prompt treatment to prevent complications.
