

# Help Improve Your Kindergarten Child's Writing



## Teach writing in context



Rather than making children write letters in isolation, do it within the context of a sentence. It will make them understand how to form letters properly.

## Build finger strength



Involve preschoolers in activities like paper scrunching, play dough, and pegs. It will develop their finger strength so they can hold pencils for long.

## Try interactive writing



Bring the child near a board and make them sound out words while writing them. Help them write whenever they feel stuck.

## Create worksheets



Write out letters and words on worksheets and have the child trace them. Children will also benefit from tracing dotted lines.

## Try different methods



Apart from pencils, make children write with different materials. They can use chalk, do finger painting, or do salt writing.

## Create a scrapbook



Take a photo album and keep souvenirs of things you do with the child. It should have photos, ticket stubs, and found objects about which children can write.
