

Setting Boundaries With Guests

Kiss Your Baby



If they wish only to hold the baby, ask them to sanitize their hands with hand sanitizer and wear a mask first.



Tell them that the baby has recovered from an illness, and it's better not to kiss them for the baby's safety.

Explain the reason by stating facts such as kissing a baby with a developing immune system may harm their health.

If someone is coughing or sneezing, address it directly, explaining that the baby is sensitive to germs and you cannot allow kissing in such cases.



Don't hesitate and politely refuse. You may say, "We are following a no-kiss policy for the baby; please don't mind."
