
Advanced Diagnostic Tests For Blood In Stool



Capsule endoscopy

A slender balloon over a thin endoscope is deflated or inflated to improve the visualization of the intestines.

Balloon enteroscopy



Colonoscopy

A flexible tube with a camera is inserted through the rectum to visualize bleeding in the colon.

A thin tube with a light and camera is inserted through the mouth to look for bleeding in the esophagus, stomach, and initial part of the small intestine.
