



Benefits Of Using A Nipple Shield



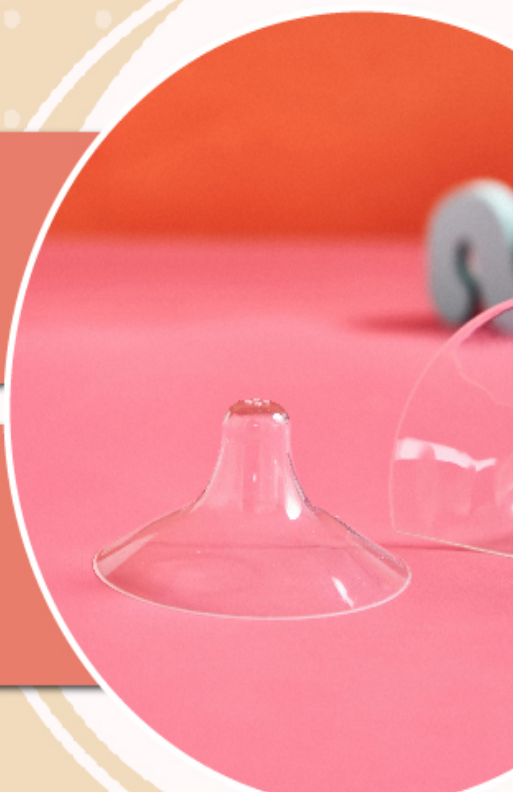
Gives the baby palatal stimulation to guide them to suck rhythmically

Features a teat formation that assists the baby in better nipple latching

Ideal for women with flat or inverted nipples

Provides temporary assistance to ill and premature babies who have trouble latching

Compensates for weak suction pressure, helping the baby draw milk with minimal effort



Aids tongue-tied babies to suckle with ease

Safeguards the nipples from injury if the baby tends to bite

Protects cracked and sore nipples from further damage
