Types Of Polydactyly

Preaxial polydactyly



The extra digit is located outside the big toe or thumb.

Postaxial polydactyly

The extra digit is located outside the little toe or little finger.



Central polydactyly



The extra digit is located between other toes or fingers.

Signs Of Polydactyly

Nubbins



A small skin flap or a bump that looks like an extra finger or toe.

Isolated polydactyly

Presence of an extra finger or toe without any symptoms of underlying conditions.

Polysyndactyly



Presence of extra fingers or toes with fused or webbed fingers or toes (syndactyly).
