



Characteristics Of Typical Montessori Toys

Feature simple and minimalistic designs



Often based on real-life objects and concepts

Designed to encourage hands-on learning



Often made from plastic-free materials such as wood, silicone, fabric, and metal

Assist the child in exploring various textures and tactile experiences



Feature battery-free designs, promoting manual play

Allow the child to focus on one skill at a time, as they have specific goals



Offer an open-ended play scheme, enabling the child to learn through cause and effect
