Making pronunciation mistakes, such as using "s" instead of "th"



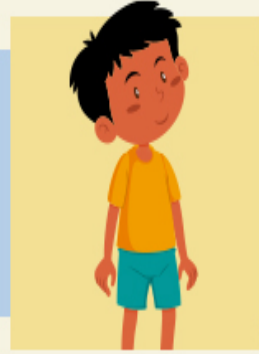
Changing sound effects
