



## Factors Influencing A Pregnant Woman's *Belly Size*

A woman who is pregnant for the first time may have a compact belly.



A woman who has been pregnant before may have a bigger bump.

Fetal positions and movements may impact a woman's belly size during pregnancy.



The average amniotic fluid volume throughout pregnancy could affect a woman's pregnancy belly size.

BMI and height of the woman during pregnancy might influence the pregnant woman's belly size.



The size and shape of the belly and uterus may vary with the woman's age during pregnancy.
