



DON'TS OF MANAGING FEVER IN A TODDLER WITH



Roseola

Do not give Aspirin to children under 16 years of age to avoid the risk of Reye's disease.



Do not combine ibuprofen and acetaminophen/paracetamol unless advised by the doctor.

Do not give paracetamol to an infant under two months of age without the doctor's consent.



Do not give ibuprofen to a toddler who weighs less than 5 kilograms (11 pounds) or is under three months.

Do not give ibuprofen to toddlers with asthma.
